





The First 5 California Commission met on July 25, 2019. Based on the success of programs statewide, the Commission voted to continue funding for the Improve and Maximize Programs so All Children Thrive (IMPACT) initiative. Many thanks to Wonderland Day Care co-owner

José Chavez, who provided a compelling testament to the value of IMPACT.

The current grant sunsets in June 2020, and the next iteration, "IMPACT 2020" starts in July 2020. Funding will be for a three year period through fiscal year 2022-2023. This investment will continue to address the needs of the whole child, including health, child development, and family strengthening through the early learning and care system. Stay tuned as we ramp up for IMPACT 2020 to continue our journey of *Raising Quality!*
